REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY

Remembrance Day is observed around the world since the end of World War I. It recalls the formal end of hostilities in 1918 "at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month." King George V on 7th November 1919 dedicated this day as a day of official remembrance for the members of the armed forces who had died and has been extended to include those who died in World War II and in all other conflicts since.

The red poppy has become the familiar emblem of Remembrance Day thanks to the poem "In Flanders Field". Poppies bloomed across the worst battlefields in Flanders, their brilliant red colour an appropriate symbol for the blood of the fallen. Traditionally Laurence Binyon's poem 'For the Fallen' is read at Remembrance Day parades.

This year sees the 100th anniversary of Armistice, marking the day and moment when hostilities ceased at the end of the First World War.

The traditional procession through Culcheth starting from the British Legion Club will precede the **Service at Newchurch Parish Church at 11.00 am**, and there is a service at the **War Memorial, Barn Lane, Golborne at 2:30 pm** preceded by a procession from the Legh Court car park, Legh Street, Golborne, assembling at 2.15 p.m.

Blessing of Graves. After a general word and prayer, I shall visit each of the graves of your loved ones to say a prayer with you for them.
