This service will begin an important period of time leading up to the Synod itself in October 2020. As the Archbishop himself said in his pastoral letter for Synod Sunday 2018, the Synod is the time when we choose the path to walk on.

Everyone is welcome to come to this service. The Synod Members (Parish, Pastoral Area, and others) will be mandated to undertake their task and we shall all be invited to pray with and for them and for the working of our Synod.
