When Jesus started out on his teaching career he gave people this strange teaching about love for enemies. It is an amazing and arresting teaching that stops us in our tracks. Can it possibly be done? In some things we find it easy to forgive one another, to forgive those we love, but to forgive our enemies seems to be beyond our abilities. Why should we be good to those who hurt or hate us?

The answer is because the Lord is asking us to become something very different...children of the living God. God is kind to the ungrateful and the wicked and we are being asked to be like that. Love of enemies is not unrealistic; it is the great sign of God's grace in the world, but it does not allow justice to slip. We are not expected to give in to others or to their wickedness; all wrongdoing must be unmasked, challenged and addressed, but justice is only the beginning of the healing work that is needed. The Lord seeks for the sinner to repent and for those who can to help in the work of rehabilitation. In the end, Jesus prayed from the cross that people be forgiven because they do not understand the terrible things they do. Justice is needed to address our wounds, but mercy is needed to heal them.
