The father in today's Gospel challenges us to open our hearts to unconditional love and then to share that same love with others; this means being willing to let go of our preconceived ideas about ourselves and others, our anger and our bitterness. God's love is unconditional but Christians sometimes want to pick and choose who receives the Good News; however the salvation which God has wrought, and the Church joyfully proclaims is for everyone. We should be concerned that the Gospel actually has a real impact on the lives of God's people and the concrete needs of the present time, and it falls to all of us as a daily responsibility to bring the Gospel to the people we meet, whether they be our neighbours or complete strangers.

Pope Francis has reminded us that by virtue of our baptism we have all become missionary disciples. "Everyone who has encountered the love of Jesus is challenged to be active in evangelisation. As an example consider the first disciples who, immediately after meeting the gaze of Jesus, went forth to proclaim him joyfully: "We have found the Messiah!" ...so what are we waiting for?
