We tend to be uncomfortable with audience participation. Many people get embarrassed or clam up when a microphone is thrust in their face. TV audience members can even look uncomfortable when expected to sing or clap along to a performance.

More than most, today's liturgy calls for our participation. First, we are caught up in the drama of the triumphant entrance into Jerusalem... holding up our palm branches, imagining ourselves celebrating Jesus as he arrives into town riding on a colt, but our participation takes on a darker tone during the Passion. We find ourselves joining in with those who question and curse Jesus, shouting 'Crucify him! Crucify him!' and taunting Jesus on the cross to 'save himself if he is the Christ of God'. It is enough to make even the most complacent among us uncomfortable.
