Many of us will have seen reality television programmes following the caring and crucial work of our Emergency Services. We see how quickly doctors and emergency medical staff can spring into action to help those in distress and how on call fire-fighters and paramedics are 'dressed for action', ready to run when the call comes.

Jesus talked to his disciples about the importance of being 'dressed for action'. He told the disciples to 'have their lamps lit', and to be awake when the master comes – just like servants waiting for their master to return from a wedding feast. A challenge given to us today... how can we be dressed for action? How can we make ourselves ready when Jesus calls us?

We do not know when the day will come and so can easily fall into the trap of thinking 'My master is taking his time coming' and postponing our good behaviour. If we knew when our time was going to be up, we could arrange our lives accordingly – culminating perhaps in a dramatic death-bed confession and conversion! But that is not the life Jesus calls us to.

Church Closures within the Deanery - Last week it was announced that the Archbishop had decided that XII Apostles Church and Our Lady's Church, Plank Lane, both in Leigh are to close at the end of August. As sad as this situation is, it is an acknowledgement of a reality: we have too many churches in the Archdiocese for those coming to mass and not enough priests. All those connected with both churches will have an opportunity to come together for the closure masses: Our Lady's on Thursday 29th August beginning at 7.00 pm and at XII Apostles on Friday 30th August at 7.00 pm.

It had been hoped that we would be able to announce a revised weekend mass timetable for the Deanery this weekend. However, the clergy and members of the Deanery Forum will meet again in August and the Mass timetable will be announced the weekend of 17th/18th August to come into effect at the beginning of September when Fr Colin Fealey leaves the Deanery.
